Bangkok, Thailand – With Thailand's rapidly developing economy and growing population, Thailand already leads South-East Asia in renewable energy installed capacity, and with the Alternative Energy Development Plan (AEDP) has recently revising its renewable energy target to 30% renewables in the energy mix by 2036. This would represent 15-20% of total power consumption.

Running parallel to the renewable initiative is The Smart Grid initiative which is part of the Ministry of Energy's Master Plan. This plan maps out a framework that focuses on the security of energy supply, grid resiliency, and energy efficiency, and works in tandem with Thailand 4.0 Initiative, of which Smart Energy and Environment is a key pillar. It is estimated that state-owned utilities will spend Bt200 Billion on implementing smart grid projects between now and 2036.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT PLAN
